

The Executive Officers of the Association shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Only members in good standing shall be eligible to hold office. These are elected positions with the following requirements:

Terms: The Executive Officers shall be elected to a two year term commencing on July 1.

Officers may succeed themselves.

Transfer of Records: Each officer shall transfer records to the Association within ten (10) days of leaving office.

#### DUTIES:

President: The President shall conduct the daily business of the Association and be the Chief Officer, with the power and the duty to enforce and interpret the Bylaws, sign contracts and agreements, represent the Association before the public either personally or through designees, appoint and remove members of all committees with the consent of the Board of Directors, serve as ex-officio member on all committees, cause a budget to be constructed and an annual audit to occur, and preside over meetings of the Board of Directors and the membership. The President is the supreme advocate for the members and employees of the bargaining unit. The President should be familiar with the programs, priorities, and communications of the IEANEA and the NEA and pass along such programs, priorities and communications to the leaders and members of the organization. Further, the President shall have the power and duty to perform all acts generally associated with the nature of the office and such other duties applicable to the office. During the first year of his/her term, the President will serve as Region Council Representative.
